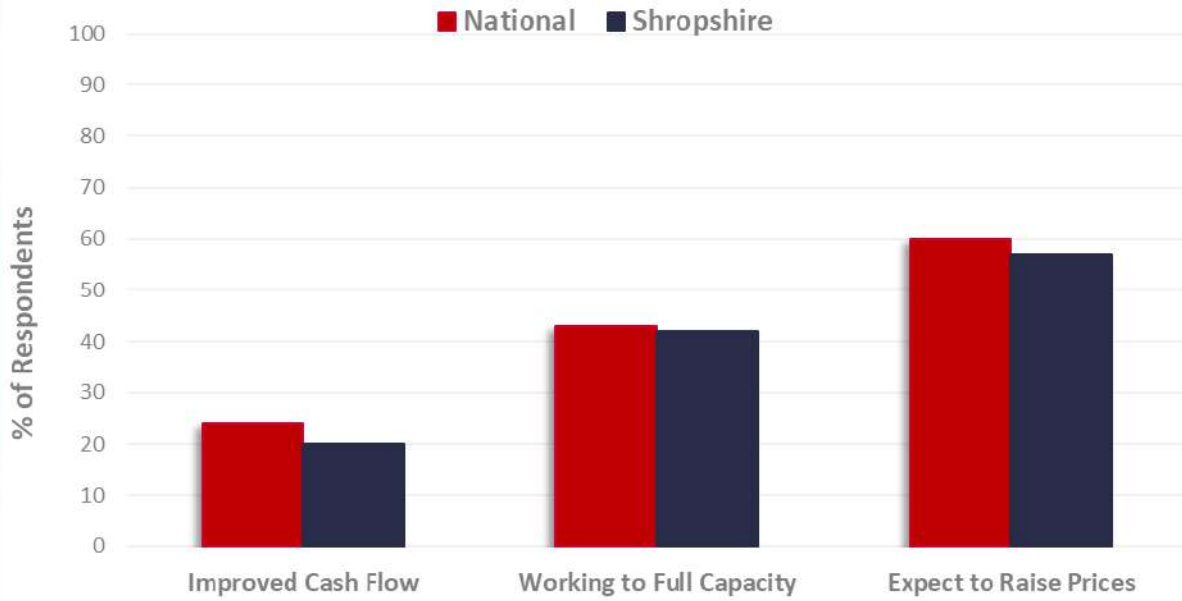

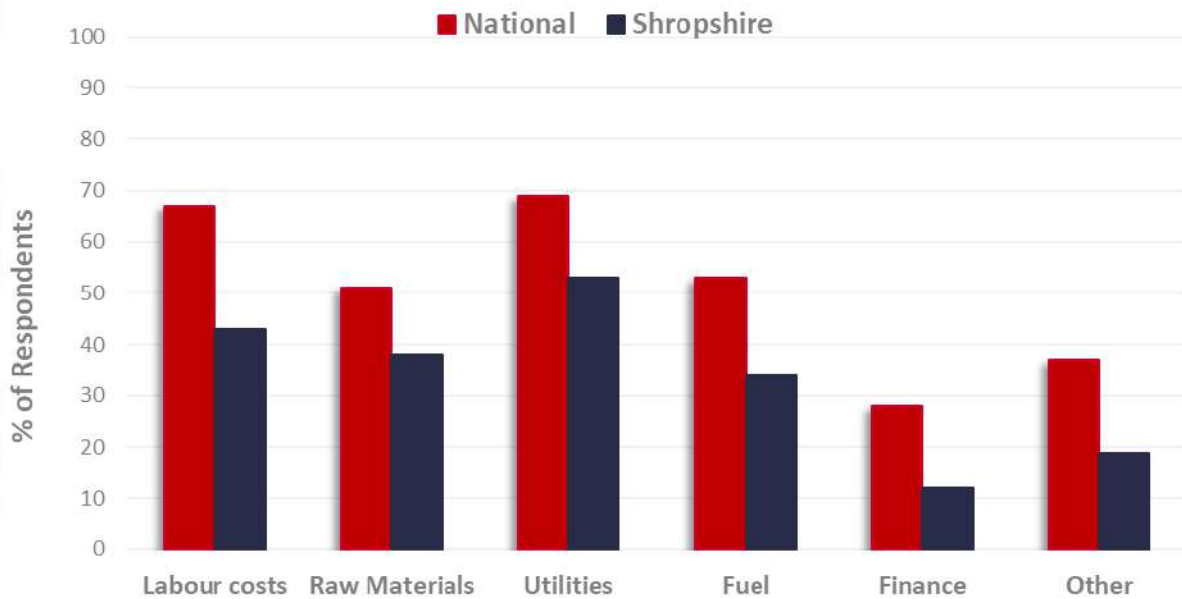
Cashflow & Capacity - QES Qtr.4 2022

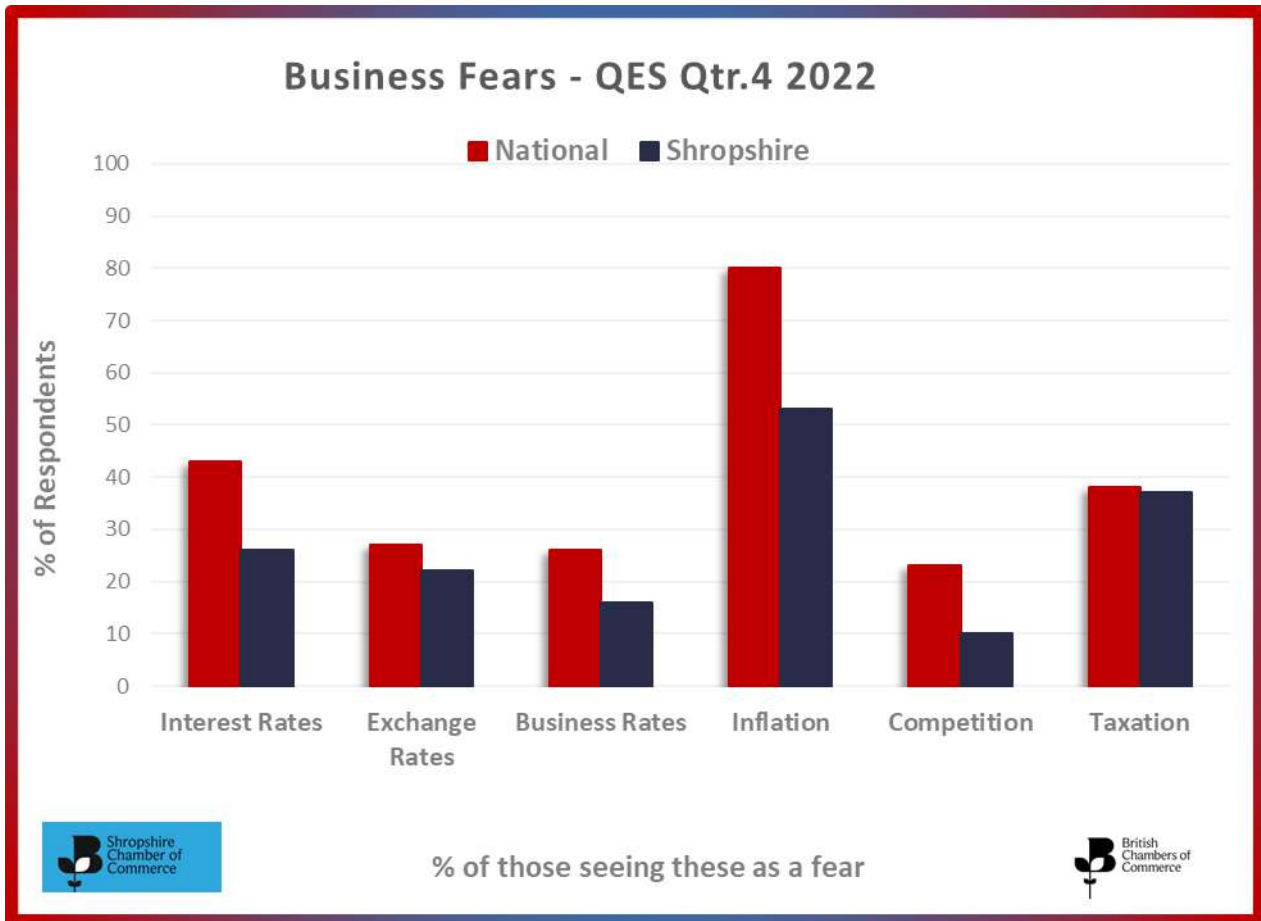


Business Pressures - QES Qtr.4 2022
